

ZERO WASTE EVENTS

Achieving zero waste in Summit County is ReWorks' goal. In order to engage the community in this effort, we assist organizers in planning Zero Waste Events. In 2015, ReWorks worked with organizers of Blue Heron Homecoming, State of the County Address, Tallmadge Food Truck Festival, Taste of Tallmadge and Taste of Twinsburg. As a result, almost 6,000 pounds of material was diverted from our local landfills. Four of the events achieved diversion rates (the amount of materials diverted from the landfill) of 93% or more while one achieved a rate of 83%.

Blue Heron Homecoming (5/9/15)

- > Total #'s of material generated from event – 266.5#

- > Diversion Rate – 95%

Tallmadge Food Truck Festival (5/31/15)

- > Total #'s of material generated from event – 2,220.75#
- > Total #'s of material recycled or composted from event – 2070.13#
- > Diversion Rate – 93%

Taste of Twinsburg (6/18/15)

- > Total #'s of material generated from event – 3,466#
- > Total #'s of material recycled or composted from event – 2,886#
- > Diversion Rate – 83%
